

## Student Injuries

What you need for the school if your student has injuries requiring accommodations:

1. Doctor's note explaining what restrictions are needed for school, ie-needs elevator pass, can only do upper body exercises in PE, No participation for PE, etc. The doctor also needs to put an end date for the restrictions. Please note if your student is in elementary school and they are restricted from PE, they will also be restricted from recess. Please turn this note into the health room at your student's school. If an end date is not on the doctor's note, your student will not be released from restrictions until a new doctor's note releasing the student is received.
2. A parent note is good for 3 days at the elementary level, and good for 1 PE class at the secondary level.
3. Prescription if any medication is needed to be given during the school day. Please see medication policy section on website.
4. If your student needs wheelchair, walker or any other assistive device for mobility, it will need to be provided from home.
